

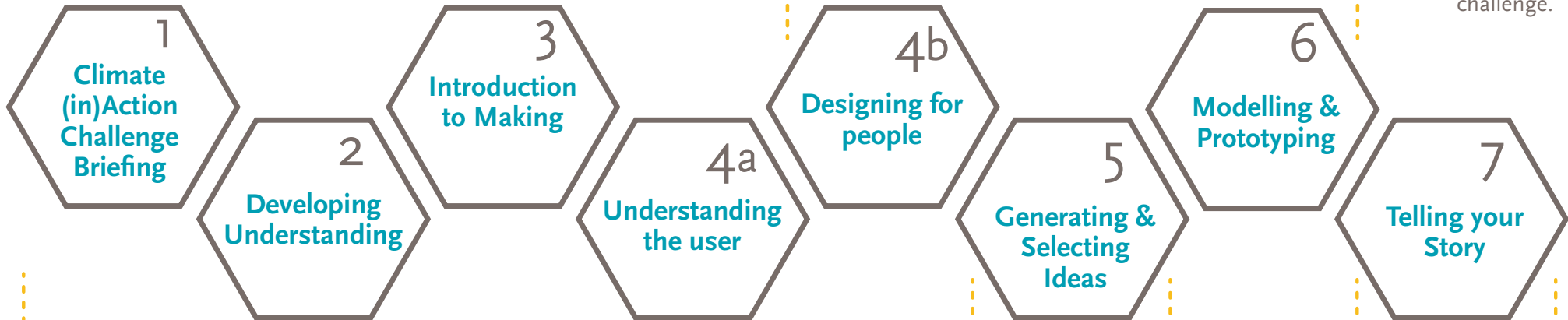


# Climate (in)Action Challenge
