Head and neck

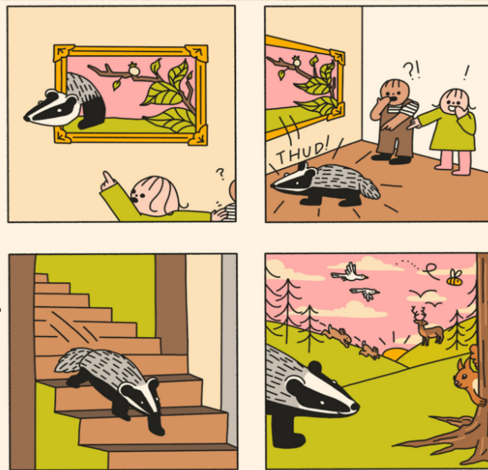
Body and legs

Create a 4 square comic, like this badger one, showing a creature from the collection coming alive and escaping to its ideal habitat.

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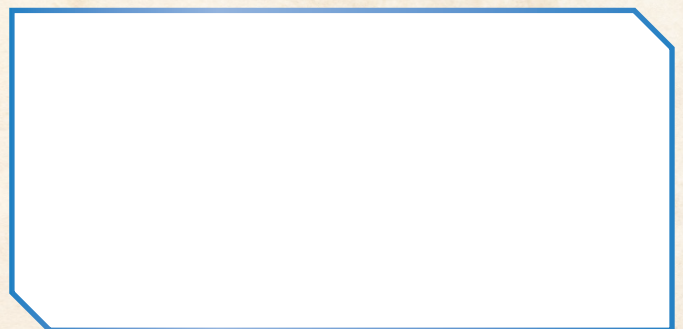
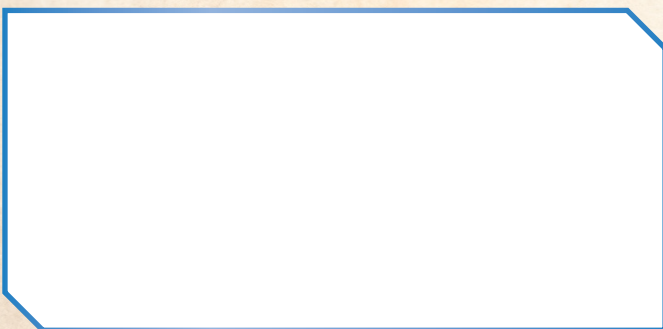
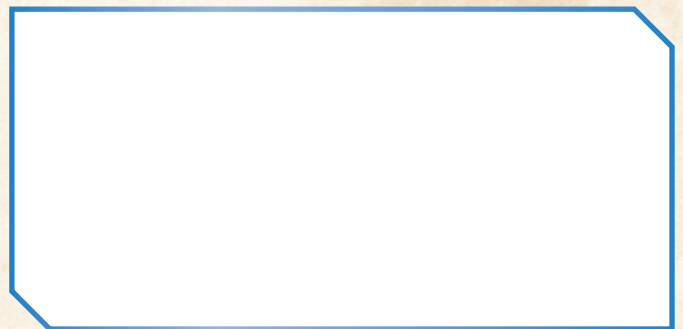
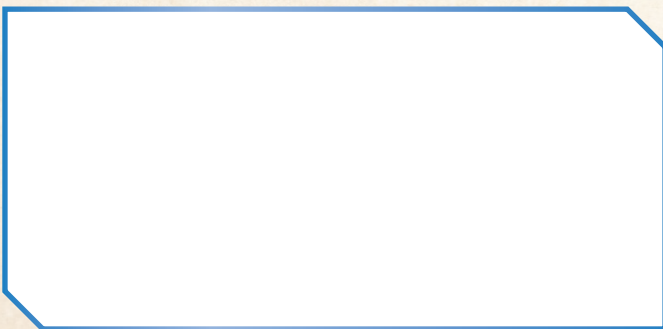


Panel 1: Where is your creature?

Panel 2: How does it leave the museum?


Panel 3: Where does it go?
